- Fevas are available for the LRYC Junior Sailing Course (JSC) to sailors who have or are attaining Improving Skills on the SI Small Boat Sailing Scheme.
- Laser Bahias are available for the LRYC Junior Sailing Course (JSC) to sailors who have or are attained Level 4 on the SI Small Boat Sailing Scheme.
- The rental fee shall be decided by the Executive from time to time and shall include a sum for insurance, wear and tear. A refundable deposit shall be payable.
- The hirer and his or her parent/guardian shall be responsible for the stowage and safe return of the boat and shall be liable for any loss or damage incurred while in his or her care and not covered by the LRYC Insurance Policy. All boat parts are marked, where possible, with the boat number. As with 'owned boats', it is recommended that bungs, ties, sheets shackles etc should be brought home each evening for safe keeping. The hirer must replace any boat parts which go missing. **Parents need to impress on the children the importance of respecting other peoples' property and of taking responsibility for their own equipment.**
- Boats will be issued to hirers by John McGonigle at 6pm on the Sunday before the rental period begins, i.e. Sunday June 30th, or by arrangement. Hirers must be accompanied by their parent or guardian and will be required to inspect the boat and to sign a form indicating that they will be responsible for the proper care and maintenance of the boat while it is in their care. Boats will be returned by the hirer, together with his or her parent or guardian, to John McGonigle on the Friday evening at the end of their rental period when they will be inspected and the deposit returned, where appropriate.
- All boat users must wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times.
- Rescue personnel on duty must be informed when the boat is being taken out and of the helmsman and crew of each boat. Boat crews must obey the instructions of the rescue personnel.
- The boat may not be lent or re-hired to others by the hirer.
- All damage must be reported immediately to John McGonigle or other nominated person.

- It is not permissible to remove the boats from the club sailing areas.
- The final decision on weather conditions and sailing experience shall reside with the Senior Instructor or his nominee.
- Training sails (where available) only to be used, except when participating in a racing event by prior agreement with John McGonigle.
- Please note if hiring a Feva it may be required for one day during the JSC as the Fevas will be sailed by Go Racing 1 group in the annual team racing event between LRYC and LDYC.

Please note that where a boat is being shared with another Sailing Course participant, one person is to assume the responsibility of 'hirer' and consequently there should only be one application form for each boat, accompanied by one cheque for the rental period and one cheque for the deposit (price listed above).

It is important to pay the boat deposit with a separate cheque.. When this cheque is received it is not cashed but held until the hired boat is returned, undamaged. The cheque for the deposit is then torn up.

I have read the above rules and will abide by them.
