

## LRYC Shannon Fleet return of racing 2020

## Phase 3

Under Irish Sailing's return to sailing plan, racing with mixed households will be permitted from the 29<sup>th</sup> of June.

This document is an extension of LRYC's Return to sailing plan <a href="https://www.lryc.ie/lryc-return-to-sailing/">https://www.lryc.ie/lryc-return-to-sailing/</a> all guidelines mentioned here are in addition to those in the main plan.

- For the purposes of contact tracing all participant's attendance will be recorded
- Mixed crews are now permitted using a pod system, this means using a regular crew.
- Boats that need to be launched by trailer shall use the foreshore one at a time, the next boat to launch will wait in the carpark until the slip is free.
- Once launched, boats proceed to the ESB and Clonmacnoise jetties and keep distance from other rigging boats.
- When using the north shore keep 2 meters from other crews, if this is not possible wait for the other crew to clear the area.
- The PRO for the evening will perform a risk assessment of the weather conditions and crews that intend to sail as per other classes already sailing.
