PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT BEFORE COMING TO THE CLUB

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Lough Ree Yacht Club for the second edition of Double Ree.

Like every activity this year, procedures for keeping everyone safe and secure from Covid 19 is our first consideration. The procedures that we have outlined in this document must be adhered to.

PLEASE NOTE: Only registered participants may visit the club at any time during the regatta.

Please forward this letter to all members of your party.

- For the purposes of contact tracing we ask all visitors to the regatta to register on the Covid 19 contact tracing form at www.lryc.ie, indicating the duration of their stay.
- We encourage everyone to use the government contact tracing app <https://www2.hse.ie/conditions/coronavirus/testing/contact-tracing.html>
- Any person who is feeling unwell and is displaying the symptoms of Covid 19 or have reason to believe that they have been exposed to Covid 19, must withdraw from the regatta program and advise accordingly.
- Participants are required to maintain a 2 meter social distance as much as possible
- Sanitisers are positioned around the club. Please use on arrival. Personal sanitisers are encouraged
- Briefings will be outdoors to maximise social distancing
- Please do not invite visitors to the club.
- Launching boats will take place on Friday evening from 18:00 to 21:00 and on Saturday from 8:00 to 10:00

Arrival

- Marshalls will direct you to the drop down area where boats will be unloaded.
- Boats will be directed to the rigging area on the shore
- Road trailers will be stored in the back field as directed.
- Cars will be directed to the parking area or camping area if camping.

Camping

Registration

- Please wear a face mask during registration
- Only one person may enter the registration area at any one time
- Download and fill the necessary forms before arriving to limit the time spent in registration.

Documents required to be submitted on arrival:

- Covid-19 Health Check Lists (for every member of your party)
- Double Ree Declaration Form
- Rib registration, if bringing one.

Saturday morning briefing

- The briefing will be outside at 10:30 to enable social distancing.

Rigging and Launching

- Everyone on the foreshore must wear a facemask
- Sailors may remove the face masks just before launching
- Sailors will be grouped in pods of a maximum of 7 boats. Boats from the same club should be grouped together.
- A social distance of 2 meters must be maintained
- Tally bands will be issued just prior to launching
