DINGHY PARKING (Charges per Sailing Season generally April to end October): SODs €40 Optimist, Mirrors, Lasers, Fevas & 420s €30 Others on application

WINTER STORAGE (Generally, November to end March):

Old Boathouse (Optimists) Available as part of winter training program only. Cost is included in the training fee. Cruisers/Keelboats on Hard Standing Unsecured & jetty for season €400 For dinghies, indoor winter storage is available upstairs over the new boathouse, SODs €120, Mirrors €60 Others on application.

USAGE AND CHARGES FOR ELECTRICITY Non-metered boats/caravans etc. may use plug-in cables, but only after application and payment of the required charge, which has been set at  $\notin$ 70.00 (not including the Annual Regatta). An adhesive receipt will be issued which must be attached to the cable. The power supply is limited and as a result, for example: bar heaters, should not be used. An occasional non-metered electricity charge of  $\notin$ 5 per weekend applies. Electricity supplied by meter will be charged at the rate charged to the club by its electricity provider. A minimum charge of  $\notin$ 50.00 must be paid with application. The club's and user's own meters will be read to avoid error.
