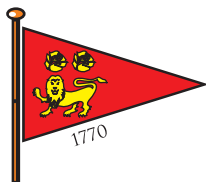

NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

L.R.Y.C. ANNUAL REGATTA

The Organising Authority (OA) for this event is L.R.Y.C
5th - 11th August, 2023

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Race Committee.

[NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for a protest by a boat.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All relevant class rules will apply except as altered in NoR 1.3, 6.1, 14.1 and 14.2.
- 1.3 The sub-headings of SB20 Class Rule C5.1 (Mandatory Equipment which shall be carried at all times) are deleted entirely and replaced with :
 - (a) One floating throwing line, not less than 10m long and 6mm diameter.
 - (b) Two paddles of combined minimum weight not less than 1 kg.
 - (c) One functioning VHF radio.
 - (d) First aid kit in waterproof container.
 - (e) A knife.

This Changes SB20 CR C 5.1.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

The SIs will be available online by Friday 4th August and at Registration (times listed below at 9.1).

3 COMMUNICATION [DP]

- 3.1 Notices will be posted on the Notice Window situated at the front of the clubhouse and also on the event WhatsApp Group which can be joined by scanning the QR code.



- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications which are not available to all boats. This applies also to mobile 'phones.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the following classes: Keelboat, SB20s, Shannon-One-Design, Laser, Optimist & Youth (PY). (Other classes may be added at the absolute discretion of the Regatta Committee).
- 4.2 Depending on the number of entries, the Race Committee reserves the right to merge, subdivide or allocate to any class, combine the starts of classes, or cancel racing for any class. A minimum entry of three boats per class will be required for a start.
- 4.3 Entries shall be completed online at <https://www.lryc.ie/event/annual-regatta-entry/> and will be accepted up to and including Friday 4th August at 18.00.

5 FEES

- 5.1 All relevant Association dues, Club and entry fees must be paid, and declaration and registration forms duly completed in advance of a boat competing in the regatta.
- 5.2 Required fees are as follows:

- 5.3 Where entries and relevant fees are received on or before Friday 28th July, 2023, a reduction of €30 will apply to each Family Race Entry subject to a maximum race entry fee per family of €260 (after discount).

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

- 6.1 Class Rules relating to numbers of crew shall apply, except, as notified by the Regatta Committee. This changes *RRS* 87.

7 ADVERTISING [NP] [DP]

- 7.1 Competitor advertising will only be allowed if prior permission is sought and obtained in writing from the Regatta Committee.

8 QUALIFYING AND FINAL SERIES *(Not applicable to this event.)*

9 SCHEDULE

9.1 *Registration and Ticket Collection*

Registration will take place in the Clubhouse on:
Friday 4th August between 19.00 & 20.00 and
Saturday 5th August between 10.00 & 12.00 and between 14.00 & 14.30.

9.2 *Briefings*

There will be a Competitors' Briefing at the Clubhouse on Saturday 5th August at 09.30 followed by a Juniors' Briefing which will take place at the steps on the lawn in front of the clubhouse.

9.3 *Racing*

Racing is scheduled as set out in the Sailing Schedule (pages 5-8 of this document).

- 9.4 The schedule of other races may, at the discretion of the Regatta Committee, be amended except that there will be no race started before the scheduled time of the first race for any specific class.

- 9.5 No warning signal will be made for any race after 15.00 on Friday 11th August.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION [DP]

Boats may be inspected at any time.

11 CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

- 11.1 All competitors shall wear adequate personal flotation devices at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Dry suits and wet suits are not adequate personal flotation devices. This changes *RRS* 40.

12 VENUE

Racing areas will be based from L.R.Y.C. and will be further described in the SIs.

13 COURSES

Courses will be described in the SIs. Courses for each race to be sailed will be indicated at least 30 minutes before the start, unless otherwise indicated.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 The first two sentences of *RRS* 44.1 are changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more *rules* of *RRS* Part 2 or *RRS* 31 in an incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more *rules* of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty."
- 14.2 Except if the course is shortened to finish at the windward mark, penalties while in the zone of the windward mark or on an offset/wing mark leg may be delayed and taken as soon as possible on the downwind leg. This changes *RRS* 44.2.

15 SCORING

- 15.1 See pages 9 & 10 for Discards that will be applied.
15.2 Handicaps where relevant will be further described with the SIs.

16 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS *(Not applicable to this event.)*

17 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS *(Not applicable to this event.)*

18 BERTHING [DP] [NP]

Berthing spaces afloat and ashore, where available, will be allocated ON THE BASIS OF ENTRIES RECEIVED BY Friday 28th July and will be displayed online by Wednesday 2nd August. (This includes accommodation vessels) Boats shall be berthed in their allocated spaces. Please obey instructions from the beachmaster/s.

19 HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS [DP]

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee

21.2 MEDIA WAIVER: Competitors give their consent to the OA to use or to license the use of their name, comments, photographs and likenesses as it sees fit for the promotion of the Club & Regatta. The OA reserves the right to use or to license the use of any images and sound recordings during the event free of charge. The OA will use personal data for the purpose of administering the event.

22 RISK STATEMENT AND DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

23 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate and valid, third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover per incident of €3 million (Junior Fleet €1.5 million) or the equivalent.

24 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as described in pages 5-10 of this document. Trophies are to be returned by arrangement to Emer Nooney at the start of next season. Phone: 085 164 8553. Engraving of trophies is the responsibility of competitors.

25 FURTHER INFORMATION

- 25.1 Competitors are granted temporary membership of L.R.Y.C for the duration of the regatta, subject only to the provisions of the Club rules for withdrawing or withholding such membership.
